STATE BOARD OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS AND LAND SURVEYORS Minutes of July 19, 2012 Public Session



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CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the State Board of Professional Engineers and Land Surveyors was called to order by Board President, Perry Schwartz, at 9:00 a.m. at 124 Halsey Street, 3rd Floor, Union Conference Room, Newark, New Jersey. All parties were duly notified of the time, date and place, with all pertinent material being provided.

Re: Approval of Proposed Regulation regarding the Continuing Education Requirements for the Home Inspection Advisory Committee (HIAC)

Ms. Greenblatt advised the Board of the HIAC's proposed regulation change which would increase the number of allowable continuing education units to be taken from ten (10) to twenty (20), for distance learning and Internet courses. On a motion by BM Vernick, second by BM Valenti, the Board voted to approve the proposed regulation change.

REVIEW OF THE MINUTES

May 17, 2012 - (For information purposes)

The Board noted the May 17, 2012 minutes for the record as amended. However, additional changes are necessary to accurately reflect the activities from the May 17, 2012 meeting.

June 21, 2012 - (For review)

After reviewing the minutes of June 21, 2012, the Board on a motion by VP Purcell, second by BM Cleary voted to approve these minutes as amended.

REPORT OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

General Report

Manager, Joseph Grabowy informed the Board that Acting Executive Director, Paul Ray, was away in Fort Dix, NJ for two weeks, serving his military obligation.

Manager, Joseph Grabowy provided the following examination statistics from the April 2012 examinations summarized by Professional Credentials Services (PCS) which was noted for the record:

- 1,050 applications were received by PCS as follows:
 - 501 for the fundamentals of engineering examination;
 - 264 for the principles and practices of engineering examination;
 - 9 for the fundamentals of land surveying examination;
 - 8 for the principles and practices of land surveying examination;
 - 5 for the NJ state specific land surveyor examination;
 - 250 for the law examination; and
 - 13 for the structural engineering examination.

The Board requested that PCS be asked to provide an explanation as to the process by which an examinee was allowed to take the Structural Engineering exam.

BM Valenti suggested that letters of congratulations be sent to all of the individuals who passed the exams. On a motion by BM Valenti, second by BM Frantz, the Board voted to approve this recommendation.

The adopted amendments to the Board's CPC regulation were posted in the July 2, 2012 NJ register without change, and are now in effect. Vice President Purcell informed the Board that the CPC Approval form needs additional enhancements and requested it be linked to the final regulations on the Boards' web page

Staff Manager, Grabowy informed the Board that PCS, in its administration of the April 2012 professional examinations, used the Element Ewing Hotel in Ewing, NJ, as the overflow site for the West Trenton firehouse. The October 2012 examinations will be held on October 26 and 27, 2012.

BM Jones requested that the title on the heading of the "Map Filing Law" currently on the Board's website be changed to the "Title Recordation Act".

This report was noted for the record.

2. License Self-Reporting of Convictions

The Board reiterated its delegation of authority to the Board staff to address the responses from licensees of their self reporting of convictions up to the level of a misdemeanor. Responses at or below the level of a misdemeanor would be listed on the agenda with a recommendation for no action to be taken. Misdemeanors with extenuating circumstances will be presented for full Board review.

3. Approval of CPC Providers

Staff Manager, Joseph Grabowy informed the Board that a standard letter will be sent to exempt organizations that attempt to apply for CPC provider status. The following are examples of exempt organizations:

- The Society of American Military Engineers New Jersey Post
- Philadelphia Chapter PA Society of Professional Engineers
- NJ Dept. Of Community Affairs

Courses from non-exempt organizations will be presented to the Board for review and approval.
